Our Food Bank Policy is Changing on 5th June



What's changing?

On your first referral to Sufra, you can access 6 **emergency** parcels.

Max. one per week.

If you still need support after 6 parcels, you will need to speak to a Brent **Hubs advisor** for a Further Assessment appointment.

This is to provide signposting to appropriate services, guidance on financial matters and support with benefits, housing employment and more.



After the Further Assessment appointment, the advisor can allocate parcels if needed.

From there, you can receive **one** parcel per month.



Why?

- To ensure we can support as many people as possible.
- Any parcels you have been allocated before then can be accessed as normal.
